Over the three-year period, the county has implemented 2,244 projects and programs spanning the 16 Sector: Agriculture, Health, Water, Education, Urban Development, Roads & Construction, Trade & Investments, Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSMEs), Cooperative Societies, Tourism & Hospitality, Women, Youth & Persons with Disabilities (PWDs), Boda Boda, Environment, Energy, Information & Communications, and Security. These interventions reflect a deliberate effort to address community priorities, unlock local potential, and build resilient systems that respond to both immediate needs and long-term aspirations.

This booklet captures not only the achievements made, but also the spirit of collaboration, accountability, and inclusivity that defines the county's development journey. Each project - whether a classroom, a borehole, a dispensary, a road, or an empowerment program - represents a step toward a more prosperous, united, and forward-looking Kitui.

As the county continues to build on this strong foundation, the progress showcased in this scorecard affirms a clear message: with visionary leadership and collective effort, sustainable transformation is both achievable and underway in Kitui County.

Agriculture, employing 66% of the population and sustaining 87% of rural households, remains the backbone of Kitui County’s economy. The County Government has implemented 109 projects and programs aimed at driving food security, climate resilience, and rural prosperity.

The Kitui Agricultural Show & Trade Fair 2024

Key Achievements:

- Constructed 10 on-farm ponds in Chuluni, Athi, Yatta/ Kwa Vonza, Mutomo/Kibwea, Kisasi, Kivou, Mwingi Central, and Kwa Mutonga/Kithumula Wards, providing water for 900 smallholder irrigation farmers.
- Trained 527,208 farmers on climate-smart agriculture, livestock, agribusiness, and value chains.
- Revived the Kitui Agricultural Show & Trade Fair benefitting over 82,000 farmers and stakeholders in 2023 and 2024.
- Vaccinated 1.5 million livestock, safeguarding livelihoods and boosting household incomes.
- Established 41 cluster irrigation projects and rehabilitated seven others, benefitting approximately 12,000 farmers.
- Constructed Muangeni Livestock Sale Yard and Meko Ma Kaongoa Market Shed in Athi Ward to boost trade.
- Issued 21 additional motorcycles to agricultural extension officers in collaboration with the National Agricultural Value Chain Development Project (NAVCDP), bringing the total to 99 motorcycles.
- Profiled 229,396 farmers and onboarded 280 youth agripreneurs under NAVCDP for digital market and finance access.
- Formed 40 ward-based farmer SACCOs under NAVCDP to expand affordable credit facilities.
- Partnered with the Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA) to support eight women’s groups from Mutomo/Kibwea, Athi and Kauwi wards with 164 water tanks (10,000-litre) for kitchen gardening, improving nutrition and incomes.

663 WATER PROJECTS

The County Government of Kitui has implemented 663 water projects countywide to expand access to safe, reliable, and affordable water.

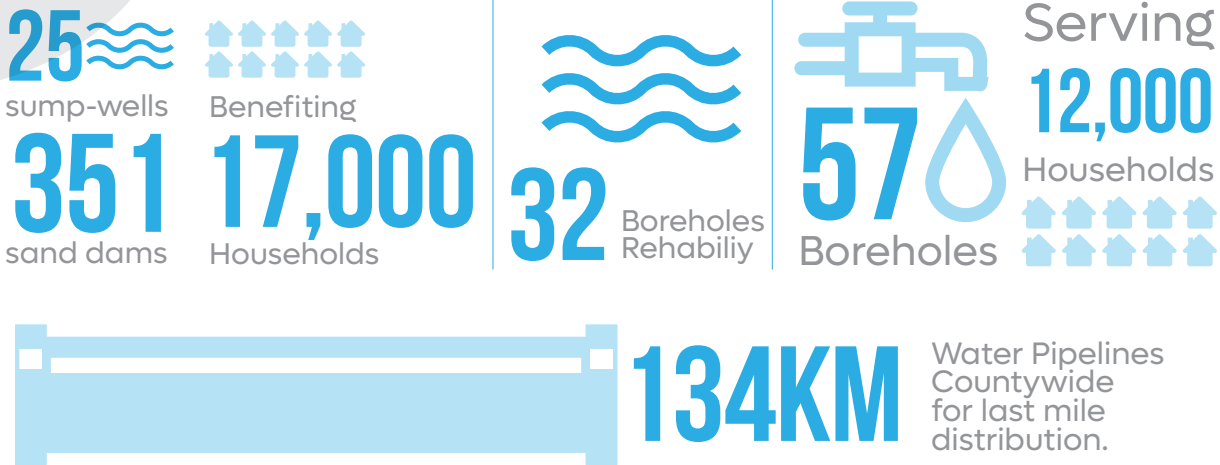

Key Interventions:

- Constructed 25 sump-wells and 351 sand dams, benefiting over 17,000 households and boosting groundwater recharge.
- Constructed 22 and desilted 49 earth dams, enhancing water availability for 3,550 households.
- Drilled 57 boreholes, equipped 32, and rehabilitated 11, serving over 12,000 households.
- Installed/rehabilitated 134 km of pipelines for last-mile water distribution.
- Provided 253 water tanks (10,000 litres each) to schools, markets, and public institutions.
- Commissioned the Kshs. 839.7M flagship Kangu Kangu Water Project to supply clean and safe water to over 25,000 households in Kitui South and Kitui Rural.

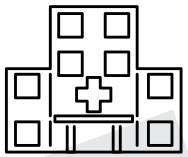

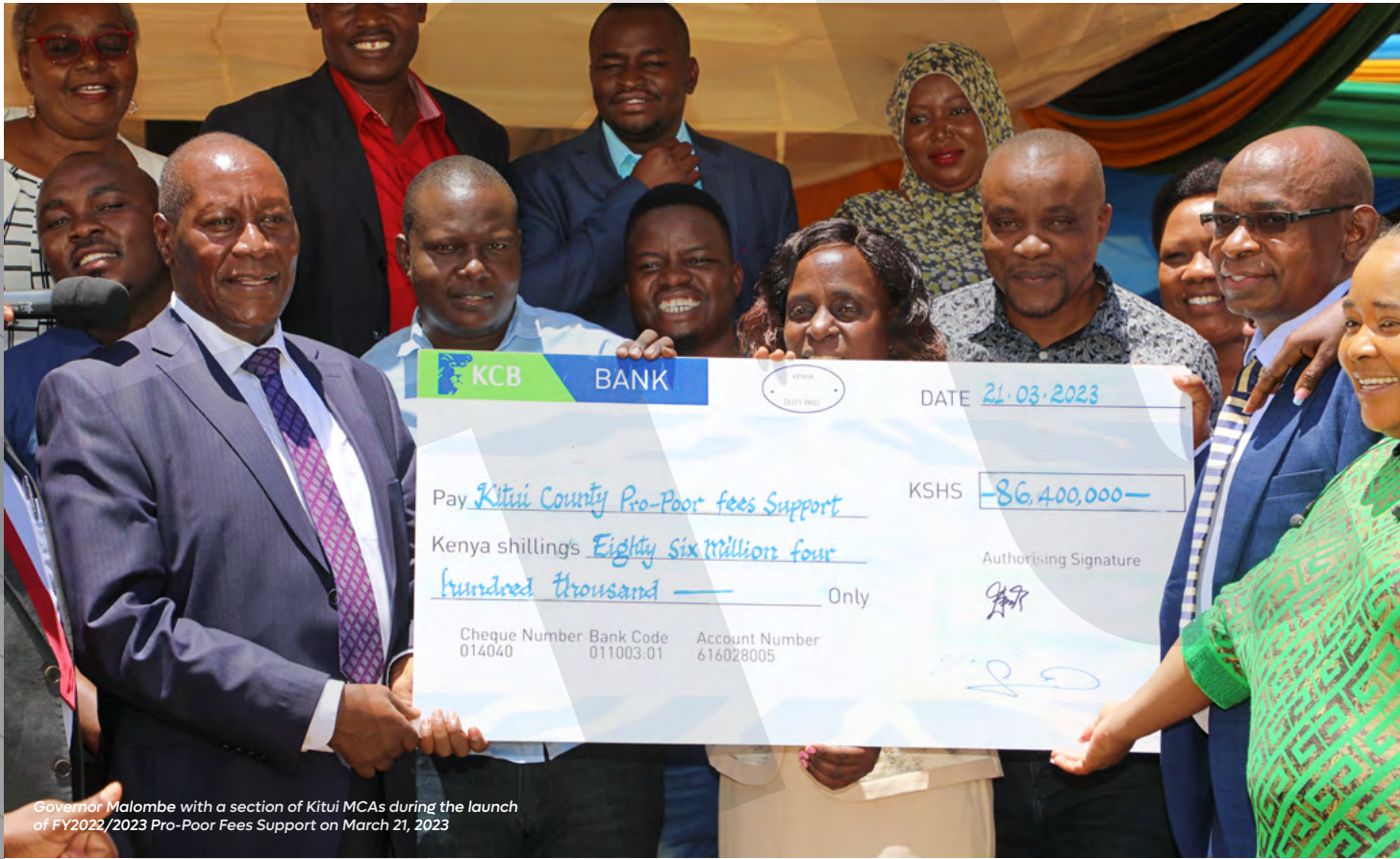

11. Women, Youth and Persons With Disabilities

In pursuit of an inclusive and just society, the County Government of Kitui has implemented **64 projects and programs** to promote equity, dignity, and social justice while unlocking the potential of women, youth, and PWDs.

Key Interventions:

- Upgraded 22 public playgrounds, benefiting over 20,000 youth in nurturing sporting talent.
- Initiated development of Kivou and Kyoani stadia (each on 7-acre piece of land) to provide modern sports facilities.
- Convened the Kitui County Youth Engagement Forum (November 2024), bringing together 1,302 youth from all 247 villages.
- Trained and sensitized 2,000 youth, 1,000 women, and 600 PWDs on Access to Government Procurement Opportunities (AGPO) requirements.
- Formulated the Kitui County Youth Empowerment and Development Policy 2025 to guide youth development.
- Began construction of a GBV Rescue Centre in Ikutha to protect and empower survivors.
- Distributed 1,000 assistive devices (white canes, sunscreens) and 600 wheelchairs (with Walkabout Foundation) to PWDs.
- Supported 8 PWD groups (one per sub-county) with 100-seater tents and 100 chairs each to boost income generation.

- Trained 400 Boda Boda operators on road safety and traffic rules, and 230 Smart Driving Licenses are ready for issuance. Training of more 700 is in progress.
- Trained 110 Boda Boda riders on First Aid Skills in collaboration with Kenya Medical Training College (KMTTC), Kitui Campus.
- Issued reflectors to 2,000 riders.
- Drafted the Kitui County Boda Boda Policy to establish a well-regulated, efficient and sustainable sector.

13. Environment

To promote climate resilience, equitable resource use, and sustainable livelihoods, the County Government of Kitui has intensified restoration of key natural assets including water towers, wetlands, rock catchments, and riverine ecosystems.

- Planted over 60,000 tree seedlings and dispersed 2,500 kgs of seedballs in Mumoni, Mutha, Endau, Mutito, Nuu hill forests, and the Kyui Ranges (Mui Ward), boosting forest cover, preventing land degradation, and supporting climate adaptation.
- Enacted the Kitui County River Basins Sand Utilization and Conservation Act, 2024, to ensure sustainable sand harvesting and protect river ecosystems.
- Formulated the Mineral Investment and Management Policy and Bill to strengthen regulation of mining activities in the county.
- Trained and built the capacity of artisanal and small-scale miners in Ikutha, Mutomo/Kibwea, Athi, Mutitu/Kaliku, Mui, Tseikuru, Mumoni, Tharaka, Kyuso, Kanziku/Simisi, Mutha, and Yatta/Kwa Vonza Wards.
- Established Ward Climate Change Planning Teams (WCCPTs), a County Climate Change Technical Committee, and Community Liaison Committees to drive adaptation, resilience, and regulation of mining activities.

16. Security

In collaboration with the National Government, the County Government of Kitui has prioritized security and protection as enablers of socio-economic transformation.

Key Achievements:

- Partnered to establish eight police stations along Kitui's eastern border to deter conflict and strengthen rapid response.
- Completed police stations at Mandongoi (Ngomeni), Imuumba (Voo/Kyamatu), Twambui (Endau/Malalani), Kwa Kamari (Tseikuru), Kwa Ngongoo (Nuu), and Kona Kaliti (Mutha), **enhancing safety for over 148,000 residents** besides supporting uninterrupted development.
